

**REQUIREMENTS IN RESPECT OF CERTIFICATES OF FITNESS ISSUED BY THE
SOUTH AFRICAN DEEP SEA ANGLING ASSOCIATION
In terms of Regulation 21 of the Merchant Shipping
(Small Vessel Safety) Regulations, 2002,
In respect of unregistered pleasure vessels (non-commercial) under 100GT**

Jetski Category “E”- Up to 1 Nautical Miles

- One water tight capsized bottle with lanyard the width of the boat readily accessible in the event of capsized and to contain the following:
 - 1 x Unexpired approved flare set.
 - 1 x Unexpired approved hand held smoke marker.
 - 1 x first aid kit
 - 1 approved life jacket, with a whistle attached to it, for each person on the boat
 - One approved dry powder fire extinguisher. These have to be serviced once a year.
 - A suitable anchor for the area
 - 3m of 6mm galvanised chain
 - 50m of suitable anchor rope.
 - Bow eye and stern eye
 - Suitable scuppers
 - Kill switch/s
 - Two paddles or oars.
 - Suitable bailing device.
 - A tool kit
 - Spares
 - Registration number on both sides of the ski
 - All safety equipment to be on board and marked with skis number.
 - The boat trailer to be marked with ski's number and the owner's telephone number.
 - The buoyancy must enable craft to form a platform
